While researching potential alternate authors of Shakespeare's plays, Sean Tallow discovers evidence of a secret society that leads him on perilous & murky adventures.

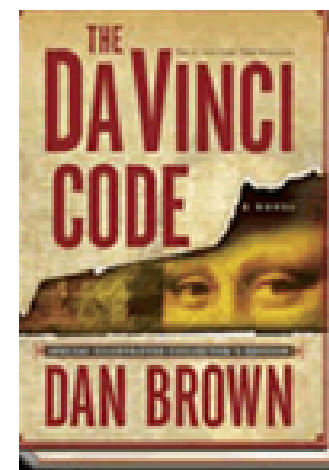
