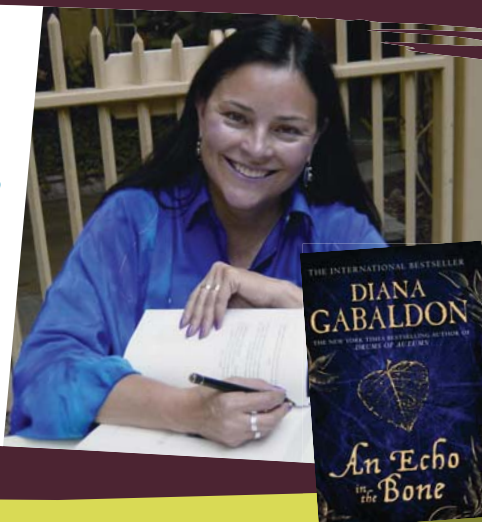
An hour with Diana Gabaldon

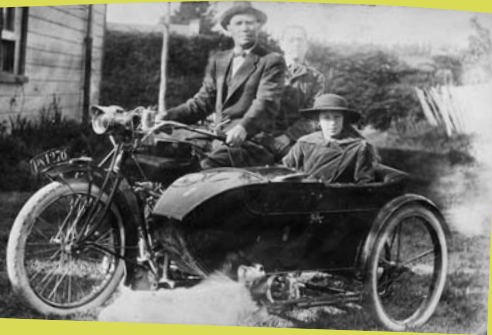

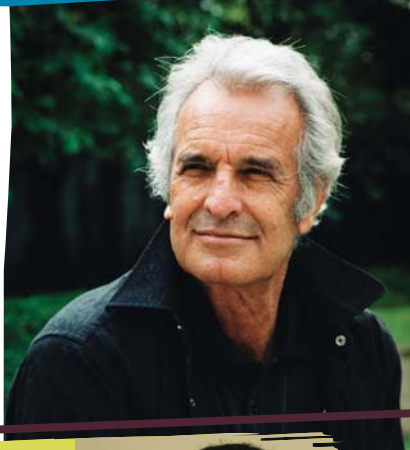
