



FIGURES OF PĀMUTANA




Thanks for your interest in leading your own tour! We have collated 25 sculptures and two murals which help us remember or celebrate people of our rohe, and recognise the artists that have created the works. All but two artworks represent mana whenua, Rangitāne, as well as some of their ancestors. All are accessible in public space (we have not included artworks displayed inside or in private collections). We have not included artworks that resemble people, but are symbolic in nature, for example, Ferdinand Blundstone's sorrowing mother atop the Palmerston North War Memorial, or Paul Dibble's Pacific Monarch outside the art gallery. Our list also overlooks people not associated with this place such as the mural by Mr G of Apirana Ngata, Sir Edmund Hillary and Kate Sheppard in Kelvin Grove. You might be starting to think our list is a bit short. We think some inspiring people of our rohe are missing from our list, for example, Sir Geoffrey Peren, Rita Angus, George and Louisa Snelson, James Nash, Joy Cowley, and John Clarke (Fred Dagg).


